

Application Criteria

Part 1) You are a therapist in good standing.

When applying for this training you are asked to declare that you have no criminal convictions, including spent convictions.

By confirming your details, you promise that the information you provide is accurate and complete. You are also agreeing to adhere to the strict [Code of Ethics and Conduct](#) of the Association for Professional Hypnosis and Psychotherapy (or its equivalent) which has accredited this training.

You confirm that you have no history of professional misconduct, complaints or legal actions that have ever been upheld against you.

You also confirm you have no legal proceedings, convictions or any other cases pending.

Part 2) Qualification and training standard.

When applying for this training you are asked to declare that your training will have met the current National Occupational Standards for training. This means being sufficiently trained to diploma level (and therefore have a standard of training appropriate to be able to work with private clients, as laid out by the National Occupational Standards Agency)

Current NOS standards are set to 120/450 hours training. This requires that at least 120 hours out of 450 hours must have been in class, or live face-to-face teaching. The remaining hours must be made up of coursework, and other course specific related study such as; home study including homework, exam writing, research, reading and watching video content. All of the activities need to be *specific* to the course you undertook.
